Item #1 Historic Preservation in Tuckahoe

Chairperson Steinhagen stated that the three primary goals of the Historic Preservation Commission are to look at landmark nominations, review certificates of appropriateness, and create a map of landmarks and historic districts in the Village of Tuckahoe.

Item #2 230 White Plains Road aka “The Ward House”

Member Gaccione stated that on February 10, 2022, the Commission received a historic landmark nomination for “The Ward Hours” at 230 White Plains Road.

Chairperson Steinhagen motioned to set a public meeting for April 14th to review the potential recommendation to the Village Board of Trustees regarding 230 White Plains Road, aka “The Ward House.”

The motion was seconded by Member Castellanos and was carried unanimously by the Commission with a vote of 3-0.

Sal Provanzano spoke on behalf of Friends of the Ward House, Inc., and thanked the Commission for reviewing the application for 230 White Plains Road to become a historic landmark.

Eastchester's Town Historian, Richard Forliano, also spoke in support of the application for 230 White Plains Road to become a historic landmark.
