## Item #1 Approval of minutes –

Motion by Commissioner Nerenberg to approve the minutes from the Regular Meeting – April 21, 2009 was seconded by Commissioner Caliano and carried by the Board with a vote of 5 - 0.

## Item #2 82 Lake Ave. Site Plan

Rebecca Rivera, architect for the applicant, noted that this site was where the Ski, Skate and Board retail store was located. She stated that the applicant was granted approval from the Zoning Board for a variance to update 1/3 of the basement area- 692sq. ft. This portion of the basement will be used for a bathroom area for employees, an office, laundry room and a break room. Only the employees will have access to the basement. Ms. Rivera summarized the plans for the first and second floor of the structure. The first floor will have a reception area and the salon. The second floor will consist of 4 spa rooms, changing room, manicure area and a reception area.
