Item #1 Approval of minutes – February 22, 2017 Regular meeting Commissioner Nerenberg motioned to approve the minutes from the Feb. 22, 2017 Regular meeting, was seconded by Commissioner Barra and carried with a vote of 4 – 0, with Commissioner Gorman abstaining due to her absence.

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## Item #2 25 Oakland Ave. Site Plan

Greg Sahagian of Gregory Sahagian and Sons, representing Central Korean United Methodist Church, noted that he appeared before the Sign and Awning Board and they requested Planning Board approval.
