Item #1 Approval of Minutes – April 12, 2011

Member Pushkal motioned to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2011 meeting. This motion was seconded by Member Nieminen and unanimously carried by the Board with a vote of 3-0.

Item #2 25 Main Street New Sign

Eric Lorberfeld, part owner of “Growlers beer bistro”, presented three signs for his new business. Mike Fredrick, representing the sign company, explained that the sign will be on HDU (High Density Urethane) backboard, black satin finish background and white letters in a glossy finish. Two wall signs will be mounted on the façade and centered over storefront entrance. The signs are 12 feet by 14 inches. The letter size is 8 inches. The third sign will be placed 4 ½ feet above grade between the two front doors. The sign is 36 inches by 30 inches. The letter size for “GROWLERS” is 4 inches and “beer bistro” is 3 inches. Letters will appear to be raised ¾ inch off surface. Signs will be bolted to brick using brackets from behind.

Discussion was held regarding the presentation of three signs rather than one allowed by code. Due to the location of the business set back considerably from the street, it was agreed that all three signs should be allowed.

Member Nieminen made a motion to approve the signs as presented, with a condition that they submit a drawing of the brackets to be used to fasten the sign to the façade. Member Pushkal seconded the motion, and was unanimously carried by the Board with a vote of 3-0. The unanimous vote for three signs rather than one allowed was passed by the required unanimous vote.

There being no further comments from the public or business before the Board, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned at 3:00 pm.
