Item #1 Approval of Minutes July 15, 2019

Chairwoman Nieminen motioned to approve the minutes of the July 15, 2019 meeting. This motion was seconded by Member Castellanos and was carried by the Board with a vote of 2-0.

Item #2 112 Main Street New Sign

Mr. Salvatore LaMarca, business owner of San Fratello's Deli presented an application for a new sign. The new sign is 18 ½ inches by 131 inches. The letters will be 9 1/8 inch gold metallic pin letters. There was discussion regarding the color of the pin letters and it was suggested that they use a matte metallic gold finish by the manufacturer Gemini which is similar to the Quarry Restaurant next door.

Chairwoman Nieminen made a motion to approve the application as presented for "San Fratello's Deli" with a condition that the applicant will use matte metallic gold finish similar to the Quarry sign next door. This motion was seconded by Member Castellanos and was unanimously carried by the board with a vote of 2-0.

Item #3 73 Main Street New Sign

Mr. Michael Santoliquido of San Signs, representing Dimopoulos Bruggemann presented an application for a new sign replacing the existing sign. The existing sign is being replaced because the partners in the law firm has changed. The new sign will have the same dimensions as the old sign, the only thing that is changing is the lettering. They are brush aluminum pin letters ¼ inch thick. The letter size for "Dimopoulos Bruggemann PC" is 7 inches with the exception of the "D and B" being 8 inches.

Member Castellanos made a motion to approve the application as presented for "Dimopoulos Bruggemann PC". This motion was seconded by Chairwoman Nieminen and was unanimously carried by the board with a vote of 2-0.
