**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL FEE FOR  
COMMERCIAL ADVERTISES AND FILMING ADVERTISEMENTS IN  
THE VILLAGE OF TUCKAHOE OR ANY OTHER COMMERCIAL FILM  
PRODUCER WHETHER DOCUMENTARY OR OTHERWISE**

**WHEREAS:** Commercial advertising companies have on numerous past occasions filmed advertisements on Village public highways and sidewalks as well as the two Village railroad stations; and

**WHEREAS:** The same use of Village public highways, sidewalks and the railroad stations have been made by movie producers and documentary film producers; and

**WHEREAS:** Said film making has been done for many hours during the day and, on occasion, for several consecutive days; and

**WHEREAS:** Said filming has resulted in traffic congestion and causes crowds to gather thus creating concern for public safety; and

**WHEREAS:** As a result of the foregoing resultant traffic congestion and concern for public safety requires the Village to utilize police man—power to regulate and control same with a resultant monetary cost to the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that such film making shall only be permitted within the Village of Tuckahoe upon approval by the Village Clerk and Police Chief after submission of an application to the Village Clerk along with a fee of \$500.00 for each day or portion thereof that said filming takes place.

Any public or non-profit organization filming an advertisement movie filming or documentary for public purposes shall be **EXEMPT** from the fee requirements but shall nevertheless file the appropriate application, for approval, along with proof of public or non-profit status, and shall nevertheless be required to provide private security as approved by the Chief of Police for the purposes of traffic and crowd control.
