§ 14-40. License fee and bond.

Prior to the issuance of a license to establish, maintain and operate a Laundromat, each applicant therefore shall pay an annual fee in the sum of twenty-five (\$25.00) for each washing and/or drying machine on the premises to the Village Treasurer and furnish a bond to the Clerk in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.) The bond shall be executed with two (2) or more sureties, or a duly authorized surety company approved by the Clerk, shall be payable to the Village and shall be conditioned for compliance with the provisions of this Article and any amendment thereto, and upon the further condition that the licensee will pay to the Village any fine, penalty or any other obligation within (30) days of its imposition, and shall be subject to the approval of the Village Attorney. § 14-41. Term and Transferability.

Each such license shall expire on the 31st day of December following the date of its issuance unless sooner suspended or revoked by the Clerk and shall not be transferable from person to person nor from the location for which it is originally issued. (Ord. No. 39, § 5, 3-23-1960)
