Item #1 7 Grant Street New Sign

Mr. Brian O'Connor of Frohling Sign Co, representing "Verizon" presented an application for one sign. The sign will cover the previous sign "NY Telephone". The sign measures 2 feet by 7 feet with a black aluminum background and white and red vinyl graphics. Member Nieminen asked if they will be cleaning the surface around the area where the sign will be placed. Mr. O'Connor replied that they will surface clean that area and if the other area needs cleaning Verizon will be responsible.

Chairwoman Ciaramella made a motion to approve the sign for "Verizon" as presented, with a condition that if the cleaning around the sign presents a contrast of the stucco that Verizon clean the remaining stucco on the building, Member Nieminen seconded the motion and it was unanimously carried by the board with a 2-0 vote.

Item #2 100 Marbledale Road New Sign

Mr. Ed Quintieri of Fleetwood Collision presented a new pin letter sign and two awnings. The pin letters "Fleetwood Collision" will be yellow gold acrylic letters measuring 15 inches by 1 ½ inch. The two awnings will be Hunter Green and location on both sides of the building facing Marbledale Road.

The awnings measures 19 feet by 3 feet. Discussion took place regarding the placing of "Auto Body Shop and Office" on one awning. It was agreed that a sign will be placed on the door and that the awnings will not have any wording on them. The door sign does not require approval from the board.

Member Nieminen made a motion to approve the application for "Fleetwood Collision" as presented with two conditions, that the applicant submit a sample of the pin letters and a copy of the certificate that the awnings are Fire Retardant. Chairwoman Ciaramella seconded the motion and it was unanimously carried by the board with a 2-0 vote.

Item #3 72 Main Street Return
Applicant was not present however a motion was made by Member Nieminen to approve the application for "Café 72" as proposed, Chairwoman Ciaramella second the motion and it was unanimously carried by the board with a 2-0 vote.
