RESOLUTIONS

- 1) Authorizing a proposed local law regarding Affordable Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing within the Village of Tuckahoe
- 2) Authorizing the use of Main Street Park (tennis or basketball courts) by ECAP on July 6, 11, 13, 18, 20, 25, 27 and August 1, 3, 8, 10, 15, 17 from 1pm to 3pm
- 3) Authorizing the Mayor to execute an updated Memorandum of Understanding and 2022 Extension of Service Agreement with Sustainable Westchester to continue to participate in the Community Choice Aggregation Program
- 4) Authorizing a resolution, subject to referendum, all general Village Elections of the Village of Tuckahoe shall be held annually on the Tuesday next succeeding the first Monday in November (to coincide with the date of the General Election, as defined in Section 8-100 of the Election Law of the State of New York) and the term of office of each elected Village Officer who currently holds such elected office terminate at noon on the first Monday in December in the year in which such term would otherwise expire; and

Further Resolved, to designate November 8, 2022 as the date of the special election to conduct a referendum as required by New York State Law; and

Further Resolved, to request the County of Westchester to include the following proposition as part of the General Election to be conducted on November 8, 2022 for consideration by the voters of the Village of Tuckahoe:

Shall the General Village Election of the Village of Tuckahoe be held annually in November rather than March, specifically on the date of the General Election as defined in Section 8-100 of the Election Law of the State of New York, and the term of office of each elected Village Officer who currently holds such elected office terminate at noon on the first Monday in December in the year in which such term would otherwise expire?

Further Resolved, that the polling location and poll hours will be set by the Westchester County Board of Elections

- 5) Authorizing the setting of a public hearing for September 12, 2022 to afford all interested parties an opportunity to be heard concerning the renewal of a Franchise Renewal Agreement with Cablevision of Southern Westchester, Inc.
- 6) Setting a public hearing for August 8, 2022 to consider a recommendation by the Historic Preservation Commission to designate the 'The Ward House,' located at 230 White Plains Road as a local landmark
- 7) Authorizing the street closure of Oak Avenue and Cottage Place for the annual block party on Saturday, August 27th
- 8) Authorizing the approval of vouchers in the amount of \$1,143,691.34
