Director's Report

- Financial statistics: Swadesh reviewed with the Board the general ledger, expense and revenue control reports.
- Planning for Reopening:
 - Planning is underway for curbside pick-up, initially limited to Tuckahoe residents.
 Window pick-up is anticipated to be Monday through Friday, 2 pm 5pm.
 - There will be a 72 hour hold on materials from the book drop before re-shelving.
 - Swadesh has met with Frank DiMarco regarding plexiglass at the circulation desk and portable dividers elsewhere.
 - The library has received some PPE and disinfectant from the Village and Swadesh will make plans for additional cleaning once the library reopens.
 - Among the many other things to consider/plan for are the cleaning/closing of bathrooms, closing water fountains, storing chairs and children's toys at the Community Center.
- Building: Materials for the outside steps are currently on back order.
- Grants: There was a meeting with the Community Fund on June 11. The library has been awarded \$19,250, which will be sent in quarterly payments. A quarterly report that shows how the money was spent, the types of programs offered, the number of attendees, etc. will be required.

- WLS Updates: There is a weekly Directors meeting for planning and discussion of reopening strategies. WLS has reduced the fee for computer use/maintenance since the computers are not being used at this time.
- Staffing: Raises for part-timers will be put on hold.
