#### **President's Report:**

## **Director's Report:**

\*Library spending is within budget currently. However, Swadesh noted the loss of income from room rental (-3,600) for the following reasons: Room is too small for many rental activities and parties are being held in the larger Community Center space.

\*Circulation Statistics: September 2016: 5110; Overdrive: 113. The Library will offer more classes on Overdrive.

\* The construction grant for LED lights was in the amount of 20,428. \$14,000 has been spent. The Library is proposing to spend the remaining funds on outdoor lighting, which has been approved by the State. Frank and David will discuss how grant funds can be used to pay for materials and labor.

\*Memorial for Steve Quigley will be rescheduled in December.

\*WLS has moved to a new site in Tarrytown. The Library has received a State Grant in the amount of \$1693, E-rates in the amount of \$183.29 and Interlibrary Loaning in the amount of \$1750. WLS Annual Meeting is November 17, 2016.

\*The Library will be purchasing a new App called Capira for \$ 500 .It allows customer access to the Library in a user friendly format. Date of launch TBD.

\*The TPL website is using Booksite which syncs newsletters electronically, shows new books and allows users to reserve books. The calendar is not working properly on our website. The Library is planning to use LIBCAL so patrons may sign up for events and receive reminders.

\*The Summer Reading Program was well attended: 992 children and 647 adults attended.
