A party not currently licensed for a cabaret may apply to the Village Board for a special  
permit to conduct activities permitted under this local law on special occasions. Such  
activities shall not be conducted for more than two (2) days and shall comply in all  
respects with all applicable laws and ordinances.

Application for such special permit shall be made on at least fourteen (14) days' notice  
and shall specifically designate activities to be conducted under this special permit if  
granted. The fee for such application is twenty-five dollars (\$25.).
